Complete the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC)

The B.A. degree also includes general education requirements referred to as Veritas. The College of St. Scholastica accepts the MnTC to fulfill all of the Veritas requirements except for one religious studies course and one upper division Integrations course.
