What is the Student Ambassador program?

The Student Ambassador program is a leadership opportunity for students who are dedicated to serving and representing North Hennepin Community College. Student Ambassadors provide campus tours, serve as an NHCC representative and perform duties at various North Hennepin Community College campus and community events. Student Ambassadors also serve at the Information Center where they act as a first point of contact to visitors, both by phone and in person.

What does a Student Ambassador do?

- Welcome and greet the public at the Admissions & Outreach Information Center.
- Provide various services and referrals to the campus.
- Develop an expanded knowledge of North Hennepin Community College.
- Conduct campus tours for new students, schools, classes and guests.
- Represent North Hennepin Community College during college events.
- Assist with duties and tasks related to events put on by various North Hennepin Community College departments.
- Work with diverse populations and exhibit the attributes of a successful student.
- Maintain Admissions & Outreach service areas appearance and professionalism.
- Assist with a variety of office related tasks.
- Attend required trainings and L.E.A.D opportunities.
- All other duties as assigned.

Becoming a Student Ambassador

Qualifications:

- Must be a currently enrolled North Hennepin Community College student
- Must be currently enrolled in at least 6 credits and be financial aid eligible
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Demonstrate strong communication (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills
- Exhibit leadership, initiative, dependability, discipline, enthusiasm.
