6.	■ Make Satisfactory Payment Arrangements  VA students with paperwork on file will have tuition deferred while VA processing occurs. You may pay your to cash, check, credit card or the payment plan. Make sure to make payment arrangements by the payment due <a href="https://www.nhcc.edu/dates">www.nhcc.edu/dates</a> to avoid having your registration canceled. GI benefits under Chapters 30, 33, 1606, 1607, 31 or 35 will have deferred, while they are waiting GI Bill payments. Tuition will be deferred when enrollment is submitted to the Certifying Official.
