

Helpful Hints

- -Students must complete the <u>Paralegal</u> <u>Admission form</u> and be admitted to the Paralegal program before they can register for PLEG courses.
- -PSEO students may concurrently enroll in PLEG1111; however, they must complete required MnTC generals before enrolling in further PLEG courses
- -Most PLEG courses will be online-synchronous (Zoom), in the evenings. Some daytime classes may be available, although these will also be online-synchronous.
- -PLEG1111 is a prerequisite to all other PLEG courses and must be taken as soon as possible.
- -PLEG electives are typically offered once per year. **Program Electives** (10 credits total): PLEG 1330, 1430, 1510, 1610, 1990, 2310, 2430, 2510, 2620, 2710, 2810
- ‡ ENGL0990 must be taken at the same time as ENGL1200 and will add 2 credits to your registration.
- --Take ENGL0990/1200 or ENGL1201 as soon as possible.
- -SOC 1110 or PSYCH 2360 is recommended over PSYCH 1150/1160 for its direct, practical application to paralegal courses and career
- -PHIL1110 is recommended over PHIL1050.
