## **Student Senate Executive Board Elections Timeline**

### North Hennepin Community College

Spring 2024 | Approved by Election Committee

### March 11 Applications are available for all 7 positions (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Public Relations Coordinator, Legislative Coordinator, Diversity & Equity Coordinator) and 5 Senator at Large Positions.

The following are eligibility requirements for all positions, as per the Senate Constitution:

- Candidates shall be currently enrolled at NHCC with a minimum of six (6) credits.
- Candidates shall have a minimum 2.5 overall NHCC GPA to run for election. The GPA to run for election is higher than the GPA to maintain eligibility for office after election.
- If a student is a first semester student and does not have a GPA yet, complete the *New Student Waiver Form*.
- No student who is currently on academic probation or suspension shall be eligible to run for Executive Board positions or Senator at Large.
- No student will be barred from running who meets the eligibility requirements above.
- Must be available on campus Fall & Spring Semesters on Thursdays from 2-4 pm for Senate-related meetings.

### <u>March 29<sup>th</sup></u> Applications are due at 4:00pm and are available on the Senate Website. <u>https://www.nhcc.edu/studentsenate</u>

Eligibility requirements are reviewed by the Election Committee Advisor and reviewed by an NHCC Academic Advisor. All applicants will be contacted regarding their eligibility by this Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup>.

# April 1-11 Candidates may begin campaigning at 12:00pm on Monday, April 1. Candidates must cease all campaigning by Thursday, April 11 at the time polls close (11:59pm).

### April 8 Elections will begin at 8:00 am online. All students will be sent a link via campus email.

### April 11 Elections will close at 11:59pm, Thursday, April 11<sup>th</sup>.

Candidates will be notified on Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup> of the election results. Results will be made public by Monday, April 15th. All candidates on the ballot will be contacted by the Advisor of Student Senate or the Election Committee Advisor.

### April 18 All Elected Senate Members will be <u>sworn in</u> at the Student Senate Meeting in CC 244 from 2:30pm-4pm.

#### After elections, newly elected members will have transition meetings with the outgoing members. More info to come!
